There is some surprising and wonderful news we want to share with all of you. First, thank you for your prayers and support while we were in Haiti. Although only there two weeks, we learned very much. We met some amazing people and learned about children with heart-breaking stories who are lovingly taken into a safe and caring orphanage. We learned about Reach Haiti's ministry and look forward to beginning our missionary journey with ideas from them! We were able to participate in outreach, showing the Jesus Film and sharing testimonies. We attended revival and played with the children at the orphanage. Spending time in Haiti reassured us of our calling to reach out to those in need. We are looking forward to our trip back to Kenya.

Now for the big surprise! Jenni is pregnant and is due January 1. It was quite the surprise to us both. After the shock, we are now really excited! We started wondering if this new development would change anything about our planned trip to Kenya. We know God is able to protect us no matter where we are. So we began to pray for God's guidance and He confirmed we are still supposed to go this summer. We plan to leave for Kenya July 25. At this time we feel it would be best to return in November to deliver the baby. We plan to remain in the states until the following August, 2013. One thing that we have been told and are learning about missionary life is that we must be flexible. We realize that things

happen and plans can change. The other option is to deliver the baby in Kenya and return to the States in May 2013. We are still seeking God's guidance on what to do. Please pray for us to be faithful to God's will and not our own.

In Kenya we will be working alongside our friend, Willis Atieno, in his children's home and school. We will also learn more about his ministry working with widows and those living with HIV. With the children, we plan to do a small Bible School. We will also be working with the men and teaching them how to be Godly leaders for their family and church. We hope to be actively learning Swahili and taking language classes. Please

pray that we grasp the language quickly. Lastly, we plan to do a small amount of exploring to find where we will eventually move to and plant a ministry. We are very excited about what God is going to do. Please keep us in your prayers.


